



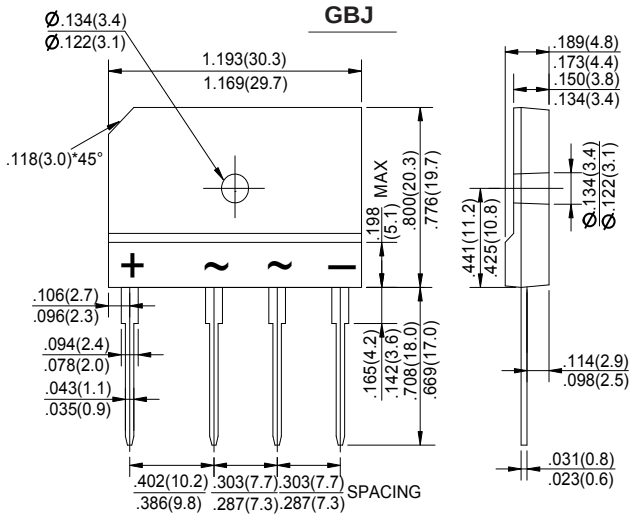

FIG.1-FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

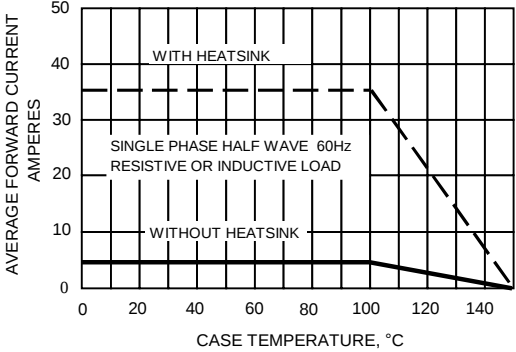


FIG.2-MAXMUN NON-REPETITIVE SURGE CURRENT

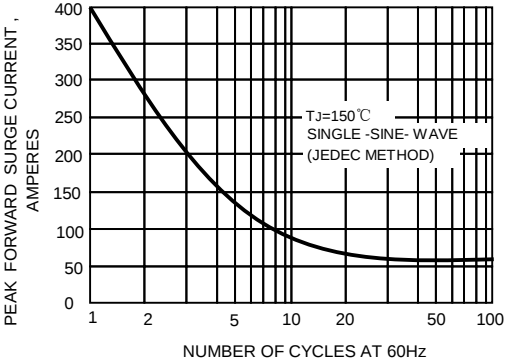


FIG.3-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

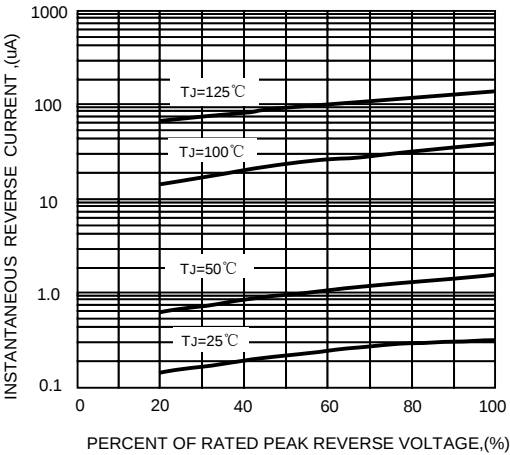
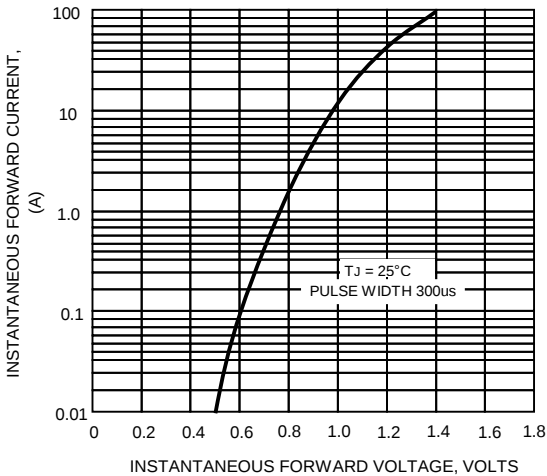


FIG.4-TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS
